

Recommendations:

Use only non-stretch fastening straps. Do not overload your Rhino-Rack Alloy Tray and roof bars. Check your vehicle's roof carrying capacity. Exercise caution when driving off road as vehicle roof height has been increased. Regularly check eye bolt and ratchet strap for signs of wear or damage. **Max load for polyester webbing is 225kg**.

Caution:

The handling characteristics of the vehicle changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons, we recommend exercising extreme care when transporting large wind-resisting loads; special consideration must be taken into account when negotiating corners and under braking. Must not be used for lifting. Always inspect prior to use. Protect from friction and abrasion. Do not tie knots in webbing. Do not use strap if it is damaged.
