Care Instruction: Wash vehicle rails prior to installing Rhino Pioneer SXB Platform.

Important Information

Maximum carrying capacity: Refer vehicle manufacturer specifications, less weight of alloy tray below (includes leg kits): (42100B = 19.5kg, 42101B = 22.5kg, 42102B = 25kg, 42103B = 29.5kg)

Recommendations:

It is essential that all bolt connections be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your cross bars. Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (probably once a week is enough, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the alloy tray each time it is re-fitted. Make sure to fasten your load securely. Please ensure that all loads are evenly distributed and that the centre of gravity is kept as low as possible.

Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps.

Sensitivity to cross winds, behaviour in curves and braking.

The handling characteristics of the vehicle, changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons, we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resisting loads; special consideration must be taken into account when braking.

Please remove cross bars when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.

Load Ratings:

Maximum permissible load is set by the vehicle manufacturer less the weight of trays above (weights above include leg kits). When alloy trays are to be used in off-road conditions, please build a safety factor of 1.5 into this load limit. Although the alloy trays are tested and approved to AS1235-2000, Australian road conditions can be much more rigorous. However, increasing the number of mount points to the vehicle does not increase the vehicles maximum permissible roof loading.
