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I. Overview

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NOTE: PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE MANUAL BEFORE ATTEMPTING INSTALLATION. Ignoring these steps will increase your probability of scratching the vehicle during installation.

I. Tools Required

- Socket Wrench with Extensions
- 5/8", 3/4", 8mm, 9mm, and 13mm Sockets
- 5/8", 3/4", 8mm, 9mm, and 13mm Box End Wrench
- 7/32 drill bit

II. Removal of Stock Bumper

1. Remove license plate, and OEM license plate lights. Disconnect trailer receptacle.

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2. Disconnect the sensor harness plug, indicated by the red circle, and then trace the ground wire, indicated by the blue square, around the frame and using a 10mm wrench unscrew (ref. fig. 2a-b).

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- 3. Remove one (1) Christmas tree plug and (1) clip connecting the harness to the frame.
- 4. Remove seven plastic Christmas tree plugs holding the harness to the inside of the bumper. Fish the harness out of the bumper and out of the way.
- 5. The OE bumper will come off in 3 pieces. From the outside and starting from the passenger side edge peel away the plastic that is clipped into the top of the bumper (Figure 3). Flat head screwdriver is recommended for removal.

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6. Remove the final 10 bolts that are now accessible using a 13mm socket (Figure 4a-b)

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III. Pre-Installation

- 1. Remove Fab Fours bumper from the shipping carton and lay all items out on a blanket to prevent damage.
- 2. Install provided license plate lights in indicated locations.





3. FOR SENSOR BUMPER INSTALLATION: CAREFULLY remove sensors from all housings, taking care to avoid touching the front of the sensors, the side tabs on the housing must be pulled away as the sensor is pulled out (ref. circles below). Then pull housing from OEM bumper and install sensor housings in FabFours bumper by lining up plastic protrusions of the housing with the sensor profile (Ref Figures 6a-d).







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4. Look at images below to confirm proper orientation.

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- 5. Once you are certain the sensor orientation is as previously instructed, follow instructions on the provided epoxy. Making sure sensor housings are as flush as possible, then apply epoxy to inside face of bumper. EPOXY SHOULD ONLY BE ON BUMPER AND SENSOR HOUSINGS, DO NOT GET EPOXY ON SENSOR.
- 6. Run sensor harness to housing.
- 7. Ensure that the plastic grommet is on properly and sensors appear centered in their housings.
- 8. Final installation of sensors on passenger side should appear as follows with driver side sensors mirrored.

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IV. Bumper Installation

- 1. Attach the supplied intermediate brackets with a 5/8 socket wrench and the provided 7/16 bolts.
- 2. Replace OEM bumper with the Fab Fours Vengeance Bumper. Use the stud plates, the ¹/₂" hardware and a ³/₄" wrench to fasten the bumper mounts to the frame rail in the OEM mounting locations. Do not fully tighten.

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- 3. Level and align the bumper in relation to the truck bed. Fully tighten all fasteners.
- 4. Slowly lower the tailgate to ensure there will be no interference. If required, loosen the frame/bumper bolts and adjust alignment of the bumper.
- 5. Install trailer plug receptacle. The stock plug receptacle must be drilled with a 7/32 drill bit (1/4 is acceptable) using the shown impressions in the receptacle as guides. Attach with the provided #8 hardware.

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6. Install light strip to the area shown below. We recommend preparing the area with adhesive promoter prior to securing the light.

- 7. Reinstall license plate with provided plastic inserts.
- 8. Reattach spare tire lock with the provided retaining ring.
- 9. Secure all loose wiring and harnesses to the frame or bumper with zip ties.





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V. Maintenance/Care

- Deriodically check and tighten all fasteners.
- Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.

APPENDIX A. Troubleshooting Vehicle Sensors

- Start with a general inspection of the sensor fitment. Check that both the sensors and the sensor clips are fully secure and the sensors are properly centered in the housing.
- Confirm plastic housing is in the correct mounting holes. Misplaced sensor housings could compress sensor and give false readings or faults.
- Use a clean microfiber to wipe the front face of the sensor as dirt or debris can cause issues.
- Inspect connection. Be sure that the sensor is firmly seated into the harness.
- Run through several start cycles (i.e. fully turn the vehicle on and off).
- Finally, disconnect the battery to reset the sensors.
