#### **Tools Required**

- Socket Wrench with Extension (Ratcheting wrenches may also be convenient)
- 7mm, 15mm, 18mm, Sockets and Box End Wrenches
- Floor jack and wood block.
- Panel clip removal tool ('Christmas tree fastener removal tool')

#### II. Removal of OEM Bumper

#### Note: Save all OEM parts until installation is complete!

A. Open hood and locate push pins on radiator cover. Using a panel clip removal tool, pull the head of the push pins up, remove push pin and lift radiator cover off. This will allow access to top grille bolts. (Ref. Figure 1).







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B. Remove the fasteners connecting the grille to the frame. 4x15mm bolts, indicated by the red SQUARES, are located at the top of the grille. At this point 6 clips, indicated by red circles, are holding the grille in place. Starting around the center of grill carefully pull grille away from truck (Ref. Figure 2a-b).

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C. Remove bumper support bar (ref 3a-c). Using 18mm socket remove the single bolt connecting bar to bumper and 15mm socket to remove 2 bolts connecting bar to frame. Remove the fasteners connecting the bumper to the bracket. Using a 18mm socket/wrench remove bolts from the top and bottom of bracket connected to the bumper (ref 3c). Pull bumper away from vehicle. Using 22mm socket remove forward facing bolts holding bracket to frame. Repeat process on each side of vehicle.

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D. Remove bolts securing tow hooks to frame. Location is indicated in image below by green rectangle (Ref. 4b).

E. Remove OEM electrical harness from bumper. Disconnect harness from fog lights and sensors. Pop out plastic clips holding harness to bumper on both sides and carefully pull away.





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#### III. Pre-Installation

NOTE: PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE MANUAL BEFORE ATTEMPTING INSTALLATION! Ignoring these steps will increase your probability of scratching the vehicle during product installation.

- A. Remove the bumper from the shipping carton. Lay all items out on a blanket to prevent damage to the powder coating.
- B. Remove the sensors and sensor housings from your stock bumper. The sensors are removed by pressing outward on the tabs of the sensor housing (Figure 10, red arrows) and pulling away from the bumper. The sensor housing is then removed by pressing the THREE clips circled and push through the front of the bumper.
- <u>Optional:</u> If installing winch into Grumper, do it at this time. Follow the winch manufacturer's instructions for installation. The Fairlead can be installed when the center grill assembly is fastened to the winch tray.

C. Insert your stock housings into your Fab Fours bumper. Each sensor position may change. Sensors housing protrusion should match images below (Fig. 6a-d). Failure to insert these properly may result in errors with the parking assist features of your truck.

D. After ensuring sensors work in current orientation, epoxy should be applied to the housing on inside of bumper and allowed to dry.





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#### IV. Grumper Installation

A. Loosely install the winch tray using the six OEM bolts (Ref. Figure 7).

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B. Bolt inserts into the center grill section (Figure 8a-b). Attach the inserts to the center grill using 5/16" SS hardware. Use the rubber sealing washers on the exterior face of the Grumper shell. Stack a flat washer, lock washer, and nut on the inside. Attach the mesh pieces to the boxes with the 3/8" Yellow Zinc hardware. Install the sensor housings in the provided holes. DO NOT EPOXY at this time. Push the sensors into the housings and attach the wiring harness to each sensor. Note that there are two inboard sensor housings and two outboard sensor housings. [This is signified by a "IB" or "OB" on the side of the housing.]

C. Install the center grille section onto the truck (Figure 9a-b). Secure the two upper brackets to the core support with the 5/16" Yellow Zinc mounting hardware. Fasten the center section to the winch tray with the 7/16" stainless button head screws. If you have a winch, the fairlead should be attached at this time using the bolts provided with the winch. Adjust the center section so that it is centered on the truck and at the correct height. Tighten all fasteners. Connect the sensor wiring harness to the truck.

D. Install Wings using the eight provided 3/8" x 1" bolts (Figure 10a-b). Each wing will attach to the center section with two bolts and to the winch tray with two bolts.

E. Install Wing Stiffeners using the 3/8" x 1.25" hardware. The stiffener will be bolted through the frame and winch tray mount with the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5.0" hardware (Figure 11a-b).

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- F. Align the bumper side to side and top to bottom to ensure a perfect fit to the truck. Allow greater than 1/4" of clearance to all painted surfaces if possible. This is to allow for frame flex!
- G. <u>Fully tighten all fasteners between bumper and</u> <u>brackets as well as brackets and frame.</u>
- H. Remove adhesive covering on Fab fours logo, center with grille, align with cutout in center of the grille and apply with firm pressure for 30 seconds.

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#### Maintenance/Care

- □ Periodically check and tighten all fasteners.
- □ Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts must be replaced.
- □ After washing of the vehicle make sure to fully dry all surfaces
