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I. Overview

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II. Tools Needed

- 3/4", ¹/₂", 13/16" Socket
- 3/4" Wrench
- Socket wrench
- Regular Screwdriver

III. <u>Removal</u>

- □ A) Remove license plate, and OEM license plate lights. If so equipped, unplug back-up sensors and seal OEM connector with tape; affix to frame.
- **B**) Remove OEM bumper fasteners and OEM bumper. Set aside.
- **C**) Remove OEM Spare Tire Access Cover from bumper. Set aside.

IV. <u>Bumper Preparation</u>

- □ A) Lay out Fab Fours bumper and install factory license plate lights in provided locations.
- **B**) Install license plate inserts in provided locations.
- **C**) Install OEM Spare Tire Access Cover in provided location.







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- □ A) Install bumper mounts onto bumper as shown using supplied mounting hardware: bolts, washers, and nuts. Do not tighten fully. Verify that the triangular flange points upward and middle flange faces outward. Repeat for other side.
- B) Install provided 9/16 bolts to the slots of the hitch to secure hitch to frame. (Warning: If this is not done it will change max tongue weight, and result in hitch failure.)



V. <u>Bumper Installation</u>

- □ A) Place two of the provided spacers over each hole on receiver plate for bumper to rest on during install, and use provided ¹/₂-13 X 1 ³/₄ bolts to secure bumper to receiver plate.
- □ B) Bolt bumper to frame using supplied hardware: bolts, washers, and nuts. Repeat for other side. Align Spare Tire Access Cover with guide tube.



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- **C**) Align bumper front to back and tighten frame mount fasteners.
- □ D) Align bumper height side-to-side, verify tailgate clears while lowered, and tighten bumper mounting fasteners using a socket and wrench.
- **E**) Plug in license plate light harness and secure to frame rails.
- \Box F) Re-install license plate.

VI. Maintenance/Care

- □ Periodically check and tighter all fasteners.
- Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
