ASSISTANCE

We recommend two people perform the installation as items are heavy and may need to be held in place while installing.

ORGANIZATION

Disassemble the vehicle where you can catalog and store everything. We suggest labeling and bagging all the OEM bolts when removing from the vehicle. Failure to keep track of parts could lead to an inability to properly reinstall components.

DISASSEMBLY

1. Using the appropriate screwdriver or socket, remove the license plate.

2. Using a 15mm socket wrench, remove the two (2) bolts behind the license plate (Figure 1).

3. Disconnect the rear bumper wiring harness at the quick disconnect by pulling out on the yellow lock tab (Figure 2) and extracting the red lock bar from the housing (Figure 3). 4. Using a plastic panel pry panel tool, remove the wiring harness from the frame rail. (Figure 4)

5. With assistance, hold the bumper securely to the frame rail. Using a 16mm socket wrench, remove the four (4) OEM bumper nuts. (Figure 5)

6. Remove the factory bumper and set aside for extraction of license plate lights, sensors, trailer plug, and key-less entry module.

7. Disconnect the factory wiring harness from all sensors, license plate lights and trailer plug.

8. Using a 10mm socket, remove the factory license plate lights and set aside. (Figure 6)

9. Remove the bumper stomp cover. (Figure 7)

10. Using a 7mm socket wrench, disconnect the factory wiring harness from the keyless entry module and remove the module. (Figure 8)

11. Remove the sensors from the sensor housings by expanding both sides of the sensor housing and lifting the sensor up. (Figure 9-10)

NOTE: Sensors are extremely delicate and must be handled with care! Do not push on face of sensors to remove!

12. Remove the trailer plug by compressing the two (2) chrome spring tabs and extracting the plug from the bumper shell. (Figure 11)

13. Using a plastic panel pry tool, remove the factory wiring harness from the bumper shell. Unclip the nineteen (19) ribbed shank push-in rivets and three (3) panel clips.

INSTALLATION

1. Install the factory trailer plug into the cutout in the license plate area. Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill four (4) holes into the trailer plug connector. (Figure 13-14)

2. Using a 3/32" Allen wrench and 9mm socket wrench, attach the trailer plug to the bumper with the provided four (4) #8-32 stainless steel bolts, nylock nuts and washers (50170-HW) (Figure 15)

3. Fish the factory wiring harness through the bumper mount cutouts prior to installing the sensors. (Figure 16)

Note: Make sure the wiring harness plug is located on the Driver side of the bumper when installing.

4. Plug the trailer plug connector into the trailer plug. (Figure 17)

5. Using a flat head screwdriver, slightly bend out the side tabs on all sensor cups to allow for easy insertion and minimize possible damage to sensor. (Figure 18)

Note: (Figure 19) shows the inside of the driver side wing and is intended to illustrate the sensor orientation for both the inner and outer sensors on that side. Both sensors in the passenger side will install with the same orientation.

6. Fully seat the sensor into the sensor cup. Be mindful of the sensor alignment as viewed from the outside of the shell. (Figure 20)

Note: The rubber seat of the sensor must not be pinched or distorted in any way for proper sensor installation. Failure to use the rubber seat or pinching of the sensor may result in false readings or nonresponsive sensors. The sensor rubber seat is indicated in Figure 20.

7. While holding the sensor fully seated in the hole and sensor tabs aligned with the cutouts in the sensor cup bracket, bend the sensor cup bracket tabs back into place and tight to the sensor body. (Figure 21)

8. Follow the same installation method for all six (6) sensors being mindful of sensor orientation.

Note: If your OEM bumper doesn't have all six sensors, then install the black plastic plugs in the unused sensor holes.

9. Using a rubber mallet, align the plastic plug and hammer handle square with the sensor hole. (50170-HW) (Figure 22)

11. Using a 10mm socket wrench, reinstall both license plate lights into the bumper using the OEM hardware to secure the lights to the bumper.

Note: Don't over tighten the two (2) factory license plate light bolts as you may crack the plastic light. Only snug up the light hardware. Locktight is recommended for these two bolts

12. Reconnect the factory wiring harness to all six (6) of the sensors and both license plate lights.

Note: Zip tie holes are provided in four (4) places along the inside of the shell to secure the factory wiring harness. The four (4) locations are two (2) above the outer sensor and two (2) on the license plate light bolt plate. Outer zip tie location and example shown in Figure 24.

13. Zip tie or secure the key-less entry module to the frame located right behind where the license plate mounts. (Figure 25) 14. Using a 3/4" socket wrench, install the provided mounting brackets (21843, 21844) onto frame rails with the provided two (2) 1/2" yellow zinc bolts with two flat washers, lock washer and nuts. (50170-HW) (Figure 26)

15. Using a 5/8" socket wrench and 11/16" deep socket, loosely install the provided four (4) sets of 7/16" yellow zinc hex head bolt, two flat washers, lock washer, and nut bolt stacks into the driver and passenger side frame rail end. (50170-HW) (Figure 27) 16. Reconnect the factory wiring harness main connector to the vehicle where it was disconnected from in step 2 of the disassembly section and re-plug the ribbed shank push-in rivets into the frame rail.

17. Insert the provided four (4) nylon license plate nut inserts into the four holes on the bumper. (50170-HW) (Figure 28)
