






Passenger-Side Orientation





Assemble bracket as shown in the next three steps.


Note: Driver side shown. Rotate frame spacer 180° for passenger side. (See image in step 1 for passenger orientation).



A. Install brackets (3 & 4) with bolts (8) and nuts (9), leave loose.




B. Install bracket to linkage, using supplied bolts (12). Hand tighten bolts then torque from steps A & B. See above for torque spec.



C. Attach frame spacer to assembled bracket using bolt (10) and spacer (16), hand tighten. See orientation from step 1.


Locate mounting point under front bed mount bolt. Bracket assembly will slide over bed stud.






Snug Sleeve nut (11) with washer (15) to Bed Stud. Do not torque to allow for adjustment in next step. **Note:** Swivel joint may be necessary on short bed models if emergency brake cable bracket










Offset the step pad to the rear position of the lower linkage assembly and secure using provided PT Screws (13). Tighten to 5 Ft-lbs using T25 Torx bit.



Verify that step pad (2) is parallel to the bottom of the body line. A shim (14) is provided to level out step pad. See image for explanation.

(11) and bolt (10) to 30 Ft-lbs.







Install forward support bracket (5) using supplied M8 hardware (8) bolts and (9) nuts. Torque bolts to 16 Ft-lbs.










Attach rearward support bracket (6) using supplied M8 hardware (8) Bolts and (9) Nuts. Locate bracket as shown. Center punch hole using bracket as a guide as shown.

Remove bracket and pre drill hole using a 1/8" drill bit then drill to 11/32".






Install rearward support bracket (6) using supplied M8 Hardware(8) Bolts and (9) Nuts.

Torque to 16 Ft-lbs.





OPERATION

- The AMP Research BedStep® is foot operated and deploys and retracts with a nudge of your foot.
- To deploy, press down using your left foot, on the forward outside corner of the step pad.
- To retract, gently kick the underside of the step pad.
- Max Load Capacity: 300lbs.
- Always use appropriate hand holds when stepping up to or down from your truck's cargo bed.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

The step pad surface and linkage arms can be washed with mild soap and water using a soft brush or sponge to dislodge any mud, dirt or accumulated road grime. Rinse with fresh water.

To prevent slipping, avoid applying waxes, lubricants or protectants like Armor All® to the step surface.
